FOREIGN TOURS

Principal participated in a University Familiarisation Tour of Canadian Universities to understand the eligibility requirements and the admission processes of the Canadian Universities. The Universities were Trent University, University of Ontario Institute of Technology, Guelph University, Carleton University and Ryerson University. This was also an opportunity to meet with the faculty, attend workshops, visit the different facilities, understand the services provided to International students and interact with Indian students studying at these Universities.







TOUR OF UNIVERSITIES IN IRELAND

Ms. Koelia Ojha, the School Career Counselor attended a University Familiarisation Tour of Universities in Ireland, from 20th October to 28th October, 2018. The tour was organised by Enterprise Ireland, a Government of Ireland agency which promotes higher education to Ireland.

Counselors of IBDP schools from Ahmedabad, Mussorie, Bengaluru and Indore were also a part of the tour.

The Universities visited during the tour were: Trinity College Dublin, Royal College of Surgeons, Dublin City University, Galway National University of Ireland, Galway Shannon College of Hotel Management, Shanon University of Limerick, Limerick Institute of Technology, Cork Institute of Technology University College Cork University College Dublin.

The students can benefit as Ireland provides a safe, English-speaking environment in beautiful natural surroundings. Most of the Universities ranked between top 5% in the world ranking. Ireland offers a 1 year extended visa after the completion of the course for the international students. The tour gave a better understanding of the possibilities of Higher education in Ireland.
