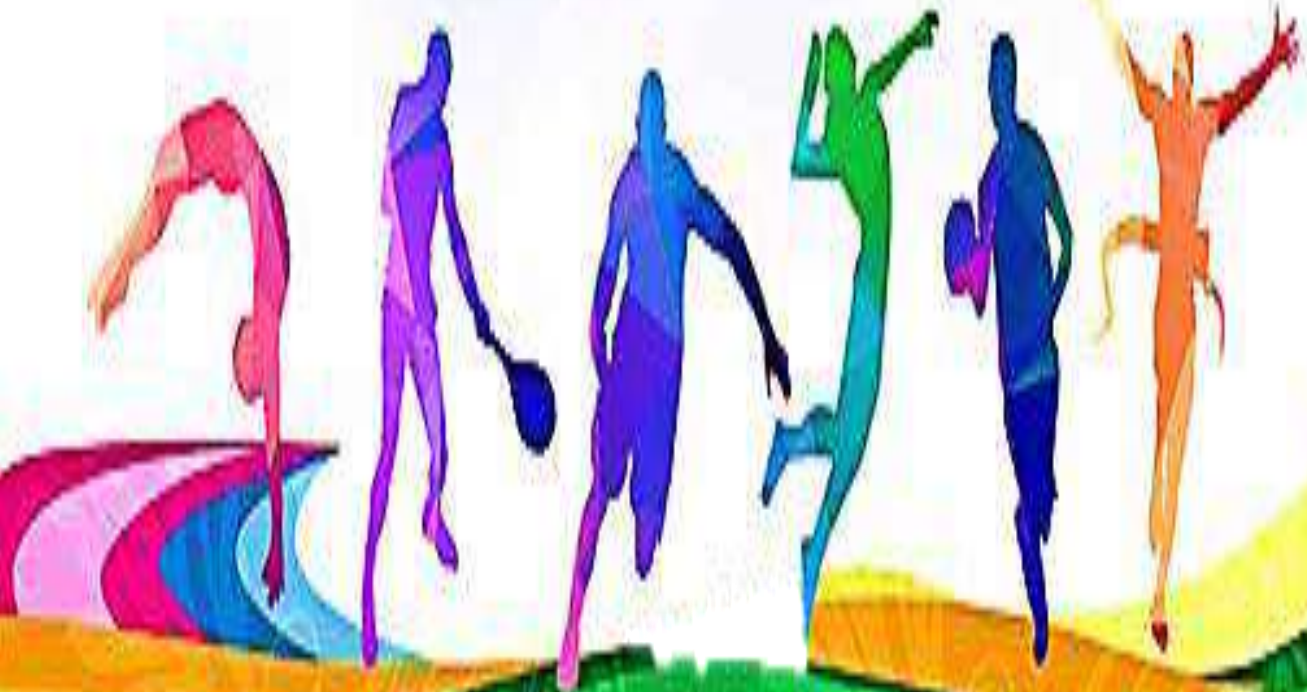

It's important to know the history of the sports and the legendary sportspersons because they are the ones who can inspire us and motivate us. One such legend I would like to quote here, The Hockey Legend- Major Dhyanchand Hockey, like many other sports, may be shadowed by the buzz that cricket creates in our country. However, a very significant Indian figure that goes by the alias The Wizard is Dhyanchand, who passionately pursued hockey. He was fabulous at the sport and his style of play and passion towards his game became the talk of the World.

Let's check out the 10 impressive facts about the Hockey legend- Dhyanchand, who revolutionized this sport.

1. Multi-talented : Joined the British Indian Army at the age of 16 as Sepoy and took up hockey while he was still enrolled .

2. Mystery behind "Chand" : Practised a lot during late night hours under the Moonlight that how he got his Nick name "Chand" (Moon light)

3. The Magician : Was a leading Goal Scorer(14 goals) in 1928 Amsterdam Olympics. A news report about India victory said " This is not a game of Hockey, but magic. Dhyanchand is, in fact, a magician of hockey"

4. Loyalty to his nation: Impressed by Dhyanchand's game, Adolf Hitler offered him German Citizenship and a Colonel rank in German Military which he declined without giving a second's thought.

5. A magnificent player : Dhyanchand's marvelous game play forced the hockey official to break his hockey stick to check if there was a magnet inside the stick.

6. An Olympian in the true sense: Helped India earn three Olympic Gold medals (1928, 1932, 1936) and scored over 400 goals in his career spanning 22 years (1926-48)

7. Internationally acclaimed: The residents of Vienna, Austria set a statue of Dhyan Chand with four hands and four hockey sticks, depicting his mastery in the game.

8. Has an award named after him: Dhyanchand award was initiated in 2002 by Ministry of Youth affairs & Sports, Govt. of India for the life time achievement in Sports

9. Remembered even today :The National sports day is celebrated on 29th August which is Dhyanchand's birthday.

10. The Goal King : Cricket legend Don Bradman met Dhyanchand at Adelaide in 1935. After watching him play Bradman remarked, "He scores goals like runs in cricket."

This eminent sportsman is still an inspiration to many. An army man turned hockey player, Dhyanchand is an exemplar of how one, with sheer conviction, can be best at what one is passionate about.

Dhyanchand lost his life to cancer, but his legend lives on after him and continues to motivate the masses. Let's take the inspiration from his life and build a Nation of Sports.

- Apart from above mentioned shows this was telecast on Hotstar as well.



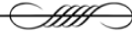
