Monthly Report 2021-22 11 November – 10 December 2021

The month of November brought a freshness to the beginning of the second term. It saw all of us gearing up for the reopening of school and the eagerness to begin the new term on a high note.



National Achievement Survey (NAS), a nationally representative large-scale survey of students' learning undertaken by the Ministry of Education, Government of India was conducted on 12th November with 30 students and 4 subject teachers of Std VIII. NAS aims to give a system level reflection on the effectiveness of school education. Findings will help compare the performance across spectrum and across population in order to find the desirable direction for improvements.

School reopened after Diwali vacations on 15th November. Std IX and X began with a hybrid mode of teaching for those who opted for offline or online. Std VI - VIII continued with an online mode of teaching.



Children's Day was celebrated on 15th November during the last period. Students were shown motivational and award winning short films titled Tokri -The Basket, Laddoo or Samiddha followed by an interactive Bollywood Trivia and Quiz.

Round 1 of a **Quiz based on Cartoon Super Heros** was arranged by the members of Students Council on November 16 for students of standards VI to X through the medium of Google Forms. The quiz topics were chosen based on preferences of each standard like Disney - Std VI, Harry Potter - Std VII, Marvel Avengers - Std VIII, K-Pop and Anime - Std IX & X.





POSH - **Sexual Harassment of Women at the Workplace** session was conducted by HR, Ms. Deepali Poojari on 16th November for the teaching and non-teaching staff of all the State Board sections. She instructed the staff on the basis of this Act - its definition, context, impact and implications. She also explained the content of policy and the guidelines around it.

Men's Day was celebrated for men of all the sections both teaching and non-teaching on 18th November. A heart warming programme was organized by the HR with songs, games, loving messages and pictures from the men's family members.





Interhouse Collage Painting Competition was held on 27th November for students of class VIII. The students were required to use materials like clothes, threads and buttons. These materials made for some very interesting and innovative works of art.

On Saturday, 27th November 2021, **Interhouse Virtual Skipping Competition** was conducted for students of std 6 to 9 in four different categories on ZOOM platform. Skipping

rope is a cardio exercise that a lot of world-class athletes swear by. From toning your calves to tightening your core, jumping rope regularly can also improve your capacity and build stamina. **Students** performed a maximum number of skips in a time limit of 30 sec. Based on the maximum number of skips, the top four students were selected from each category. Winners and participants were awarded with certificates.
