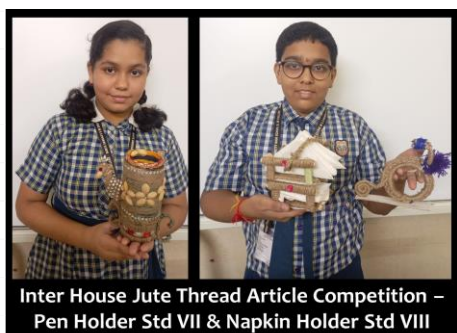

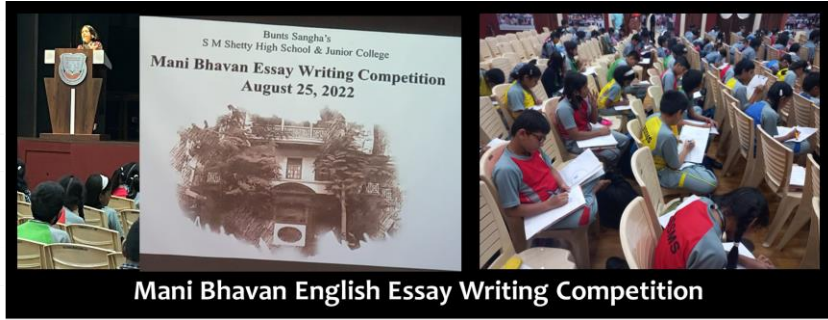
Inter House Jute Thread Article Competition –

The Math Department conducted a **Square Root Sprial Activity** for Std IX and a **Table Activity** for Std VI to build

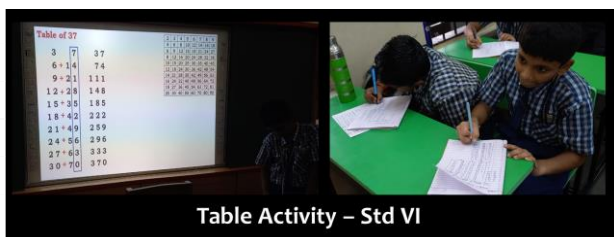
